Town Board Minutes
March 17, 2011

The monthly meeting of the Tyre Town Board was held Thursday, March 17, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. in the Highway Building. Following were present: Supv. Patricia Amidon, Councilment James Rogers, Thomas Thompson, absent – Joseph DelPapa and Reginald Aceto. Also present PBM/ZCEO Ronald McGreevy, PBM Larry Kesel, Town Justices Larry Mills and Kathleen Jans-Duffy, Highway Supt. John Worden, Town Attorney Charles Shaffer, Town Resident Nate Shumway and Patricia Jones, Deputy Director, IDA.

Supv. Patricia Amidon called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Surplus Property – Safe

Councilman Thompson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Rogers and carried, that no department of the Town of Tyre has any interest in an old safe and therefore, it is declared surplus property with no value.

Highway

Highway Supt. Worden informed the Board the Town will be reimbursed \$832.00 for the installation of a driveway pipe for the Westbrook Mennonite School.

The department is working on pot holes.

Planning and Zoning

PBM/ZCEO McGreevy stated that he has been working on a permit for the Westbrook Mennonite School.

PBM Larry Kesel informed the Board that all Planning Board and Zoning Board of Appeals members have completed the training requirements for 2010. Everyone has to meet the 2011 requirements.

Website

PBM Larry Kesel stated there is a steady increase in traffic on the Website.

Sewer

Patricia Jones, Deputy Director, Industrial Development Agency, attended the meeting to discuss the transfer to the Town of Tyre the portion of the sewer located in the Town of Tyre.
