

The monthly meeting of the Tyre Town Board was held Thursday, January 19, 2012 at 7:30 P.M. in the Highway Building. Following were present: Supv. Patricia Amidon, Councilmen Thomas Thomson, James Rogers, Joseph DelPapa and Reginald Aceto; Assessor Philip Griswold, Highway Supt. John Worden, Town Attorney Charles Shaffer, PBM/ZCEO Ronald McGreevy, PBM Lawrence Kesel, Highway Employee Nate Shumway, Junius Town Councilmen Ernest Brownell and Todd Merkley.

Supv. Amidon called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Water

Town of Junius Councilmen Ernest Brownell and Todd Merkley discussed the water bill owed by the Town of Tyre. Supv. Amidon took care of the matter.

Highway - Truck

Highway Supt. Worden informed the board that Henderson Truck Equipment is behind in their work and have not installed the dump body on the 2012 International Cab and Chassis.

Supv. Amidon will pay Navistar (Regional Equipment) \$116,900.00 for the truck.

The Supervisor thanked the Highway Department for the good job done on the roads.

Assessment

Assessor Griswold reminded people the tax exemption information is due March 1st.

The Assessor attended a one day seminar to obtain Continuing Education Units. There is proposed legislation to reduce the required continuing Education Units from 24 to 12 units annually.

Sewer

Town Attorney Charles Shaffer informed the Town Board that he has not heard any further information on the sewer line from Pat Jones of the IDA.
